1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 General Information

This text is written in the format (Single Column, Times New Roman, 10 point) required to prepare the paper for the National conference on Futuristic Trends in Mechanical Engineering, 2010 to be held at Guru Nanak Dev Engineering College, Ludhiana, Punjab, India during 29 to 30 October, 2010. The paper should be prepared using this document which contains the necessary formats, styles and layouts and then it should be sent to ftme2010@gndec.ac.in or the address given in the brochure. Manuscripts previously submitted or accepted elsewhere for publication must not be submitted. The spacing between paragraphs is 6 Points.

The paper if selected should be presented any at least by one of the author(s) at the conference. All submitted manuscripts must meet technical standards in addition to length and format restrictions. Then they will undergo double blind peer review process before acceptance. Acceptance of the full papers will be informed by email. Few selected papers will be considered for publication in the **National Journals** after **peer reviewed**.

2. MANUSCRIPT

Details regarding page formatting and typing are given in this page and these instructions are typed in the same format that is to be used for preparing the manuscript. Use single space for all text except for the title. Give one blank line after heading/ sub-heading and between paragraphs. After the author's name and affiliations give the e-mail address. **Do not type the page numbers in the text.**

3. EQUATIONS AND SYMBOLS

Equations are to be typed using an equation editor. When numbering the equations, enclose the number in round brackets and place it flush with the right-hand margin of the column.

4.0 FIGURES AND PHOTOGRAPHS

- i. Line drawings and black and white photographs must be placed as close to their first reference in the text as far as possible.
- ii. All line drawings are to be directly brought into the text or scanned into the text.
- iii. Captions of figures must be written below the figure as shown below.

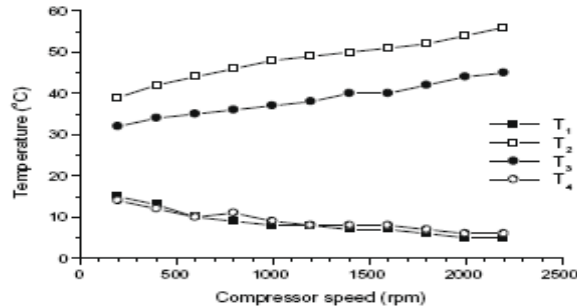


Figure 1 Title of figure, centered, subsequent text indented, times new roman 10, single line spacing

5. REFERENCES

List and number all references, in the sequence as they appear in the text, at the end of the paper as per the examples shown below. When referring to them in the text, type the corresponding reference number in square brackets [1]. The sequencing is as follows: Author name, Name of article, Journal name, Year of publication, Volume, Pages. In case of Textbooks follow the format given for Ref. [2]. The spacing between two references should be 6 points. In case of paper from proceeding follow the format given for Ref. [3].
