OBJECTIVES

1. Development of research culture in the institution
2. Support to facilitate faculty and researchers in carrying out their research activities.
3. Enhancement of High Quality publications with high impact factor, citations, SCI/Scopus indexed/web of science
4. Establishment of Research Centers in the selected domains
5. Explore Collaborative research programs with National and International level institutions/orinations
6. Enhancement of research funding from Govt agencies and industries

Various initiations are mentioned as follows:

Seed Grant: Initial seed grant for developing Research facilities in the departments up to 3.00 lakh may be given on the basis of justified project proposal duly approved by an expert committee.

Financial Supports for Attending Conferences:

- a. The financial support shall be partial
- b. Permission will be given for conferences organized by reputed international bodies as recommended by concerned HOD
- c. The applicant must have applied for travel grants for the conference from at least two funding agencies

Quality Publication Awards: To encourage faculty members for publishing research papers in quality journals with authentic impact factor, financial incentives to be given as per following:

Patents Filing Support: For filing patent, all expenses are borne by the Institute.

Matching Grants (Material/Human Resources/Equipment): Provision of Matching grants for human resources/equipment/material on the basis of sponsored research (Upto max 50% of the sponsored grant) to be made. Recommendation shall be made by one external expert and concerned HOD.

Travel Support: TA/DA and contingencies for project presentation (Within India) is given to every faculty if not given by the funding agencies.
